Use RAM Module (Cat. No. 25-3543) (Maximum memory is 8 MB.)


Adding extra memory to your system can greatly improve the performance of some applications. The 4 MB module increases your total memory to 8 MB.

If you decide to install the memory card yourself, follow these steps.

CAUTION: Disconnect the AC adapter from the system and remove the rechargeable battery from the battery compartment before you open the expansion access cover.

- 1. Slide the expansion cover (above and to the left of the keyboard) to the left and remove it.
- 2. If you have installed an internal modem, temporarily remove it.
- 3. Remove the memory card from its static-proof bag, holding it carefully by the card edges. Then plug the memory card into the two vertical memory card connectors.

Note: Static electricity can damage the memory card.



- 4. Replace the modem if necessary, and replace the expansion access cover.
- 5. Run the SETUP utility to set the new value in the Extended Memory option.
